# Eligibility for Admission

## 1. Eligibility for Admission

Classification	Eligibility Standard	Educational Background
Foreigner	A foreign student, born of foreign parents	A student of foreign nationality whose entire primary and secondary education (elementary school, middle school and high school) was completed outside of Korea
	Test of Proficiency in Korean (TOPIK)	① A student with Grade 2 or higher TOPIK certification or a student who has completed Korean Language Course Grade 3 or higher at Wonkwang University. ② Students that receive a score of Grade 2 or higher on WKU's TOPIK test ③ Students that studied the Korean Language at a university overseas for at least 1 semester

### Note

1) Chinese students with permanent residence status in Korea are recognized as foreign nationals born of foreign national parents, even if only one of their parents has foreign nationality.

2) Applicants for arts or sports majors may apply without the above mentioned language proficiency requirements, if the departments to which they applied determine that they are able to take classes in Korean.

3) Admitted students who fail to attain TOPIK certification of Grade 4 or higher before graduation will have their graduation date postponed indefinitely. Applicants for arts or sports majors should attain TOPIK certification of Grade 3 or higher before graduation.

4) A student with Grade 2 TOPIK certification (or Grade 2 on WKU's TOPIK test) must take 300 hours of Korean Language Classes at the first year. (A student must take Korean Language Classes at the first year)

## 2. Qualification for Transfer Admission

Any person who satisfies the following conditions as well as the above requirements shall qualify as a transfer student.

Transfer to	Condition of transfer	Test of Proficiency in Korean (TOPIK)
<b>Junior</b>	-Graduated (or expecting graduation) from a two-year (or three-year) college -Completed at least one year in a four-year college program	① A student with Grade 2 or higher TOPIK certification or a student who has completed Korean Language Course Grade 3 or higher at Wonkwang University.
<b>Sophomore</b>	-Graduated (or expecting graduation) from a two-year (or three-year) college -Completed at least two years in a four-year college program	② Students that receive a score of Grade 2 or higher on WKU's TOPIK test ③ Students that studied the Korean Language at a university overseas for at least 1 semester

### Note

1) Any person who has been expelled from previously attended schools is not eligible to apply.

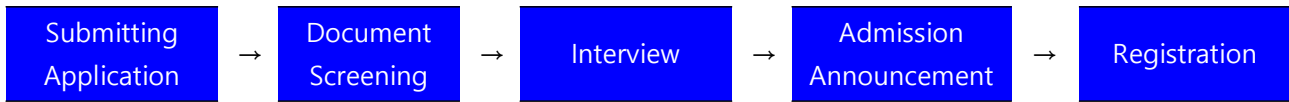
2) Chinese students with permanent residence status in Korea are recognized as foreign nationals born of foreign national parents, even if only one of their parents has foreign nationality.

3) Admitted students who fail to attain TOPIK certification of Grade 4 or higher before graduation will have their graduation date postponed indefinitely. Applicants for arts or sports majors should attain TOPIK certification of Grade 3 or higher before graduation.

4) In the case of a Won Buddhism major, only those with approval of the Headquarters of Won Buddhism (Department of Education) are eligible to apply.

5) A student with Grade 2 TOPIK certification (or Grade 2 on WKU's TOPIK test) must take 300 hours of Korean Language Classes at the first year. (A student must take Korean Language Classes at the first year)

# Application Procedure



## Selection Procedure

### 1. Selection Classification: Document Screening & Interview

Categories	Assessment	Total Points
Document Screening	Regular students (undergraduate studies) : Personal Statement, Study Plan / Physical Education : Final Transcript	40 points
Interview	Understanding of chosen subject, linguistic ability, character and values that are required to study the subject	60 points

- If a foreign student is considered as having insufficient learning aptitude after the interview and document review, he/she will not be admitted.
- Students who have the same score on the admission test and meet the requirements will be admitted.
- The interview is conducted in Korean.

### 2. Application Submission

#### 1) Foreign students applying for admission in Korea

After connecting to the "2018 Fall Semester New (Transfer) students additional recruitment for foreign students" on the homepage ([www.wku.ac.kr](http://www.wku.ac.kr)) of Wonkwang University, fill out the application forms and print them out. These documents must be submitted to the Center for International Affairs by 17:00 p.m. on June 11, 2018 (Mon). Interviews will be held at 10:00 a.m. on June 21, 2018 (Thu) in the Dean's office of Center for International Affairs (2nd floor of Student Assistance Center) of Wonkwang University.

#### 2) Foreign students applying for admission from a foreign country (Telephone Interview)

After connecting to the "2018 Fall Semester New (Transfer) students additional recruitment for foreign students" on the homepage ([www.wku.ac.kr](http://www.wku.ac.kr)) of Wonkwang University, fill out the application forms and print them out. These documents must be submitted to the Center for International Affairs by 17:00 p.m. on June 11, 2018 (Mon). Interviews will be conducted by phone at 11:00 am. on June 21, 2018 (Thu).

**Application Examples:**

- A. In case a Chinese earns a degree in the USA: Submit the documents after checked by the Apostille and verified by the Korean Embassy in the USA or the American Embassy in Korea.
  - B. In case an American earns a degree in China: Submit the documents after issued the certification of diplomas by the Chinese Ministry of Education & the Center for Certification of Diplomas.

  - ③ Official commission agency of Confucius institute in Seoul (Apply through the Korean-Chinese Cultural Cooperation Research at <http://www.cis.or.kr> Contact: 02-554-2668)
3. How to submit Chinese applicants' supporting documents of diplomas
- ① If your highest level of education is high school.
    - A. Public High School Graduate (Please choose one of the following)
      - Gaokao(高考) transcripts (verification from the Ministry of education: <http://www.cdgdc.edu.cn>) and graduation diploma (issued by principal)
      - Huikao(會考) verification of acceptance or Huikao(會考) transcript (verification from the Ministry of education: <http://www.cdgdc.edu.cn>) and graduation diploma (issued by principal)  
In the case of those who intend on graduating, the principal can issue a transcript (at least 3 years 2 semesters) as an alternative to the graduation diploma.
    - B. Secondary (Vocational) High School Graduates: Graduation diploma (verification from the Ministry of Education: <http://www.cdgdc.edu.cn>)
  - ② If your highest level of education is beyond college.
    - Confirmation of degree or indication of degree on graduation diploma (verification from the Ministry of Education: <http://www.cdgdc.edu.cn>) will be presented.
  - ③ If you are currently enrolled in college in China and transfer to Wonkwang University
    - Verification of enrollment from the Ministry of Education ([www.chsi.com.cn](http://www.chsi.com.cn)) or confirmation of enrollment from currently attending college (issued by the college)
4. In case an applicant's graduation year is different from that of his or her application to Wonkwang University, attach objective documentation proving what the applicant has been doing after graduation and material showing the applicant's will to continue study. Also, another supporting document from the

applicant's school on that account is required. All documentation are to be accompanied by a Korean translation.

## 2) Financial Documents

1. Bank Statement: Submit after confirmation of admission.

1) Overseas applicants: The applicant shall submit a bank statement with a balance of US \$ 18,000 (Y 120,000, within one month from the date of issue of the certificate)

2) Applicants residing in Korea:

①The applicant (Visa D4→ D2) shall submit a copy of bank statement that shows a deposit of **₩21,000,000** (within one month from the date of issue of the certificate).

②A transfer applicant residing in Korea (D2 visa holder) shall submit a copy of bankbook that shows a deposit of **₩21,000,000** (within one month from the date of issue of the certificate).

### Note

- The Certificate of bank deposits should be submitted with a copy of bank book.
- When applying for Recognition of Visa Issuance, you must submit a bank statement issued within one month.
- The Certificate of bank deposits should be the original from the bank, including the contact address, telephone number, etc.
- Additional Documentation for Residents of China: In addition to a bank statement, an applicant shall also submit a photo copy of the page of a bank book that contains personal information of the account holder as well as a photo copy of the page that contains the information regarding the latest deposit balance.

### Note for Preparing the Application Form and Personal Statement

- 1) All required documents submitted for admission must be originals. Diplomas and transcripts must have a confirmation of translator and translation attached.
- 2) Those applicants who qualify as Foreign Students and have a passport, must record their name on the application form as it appears on their passport. All required information shall be accurately entered in Korean. Applicants shall be responsible for omissions, typographical errors, or any mistake in the application form.
- 3) Changing of department is not allowed once the application has been accepted.
- 4) Applicants must record full contact information including name, address, phone numbers and e-mail (domestic and international). Wonkwang University is not responsible for any problem or disadvantage to applicants due to incorrect contact information.
- 5) The personal statement should include details of the applicant's process of growing up and educational background, special (extracurriculum) activities, view on life, future ambition, motivation to apply, and other special information that demonstrates his/her full potential.
- 6) An applicant in art or sports shall record his/her experience and awards when preparing the personal statement.



- 7) In case the information on the application for admission is falsely provided or the attached documents are invalid, the applicant may be subject to exclusion from the admission process.
- 8) The submitted documents are not returned. And also you may be asked to submit extra documents for your application.

# Scholarship

After admission, students must submit their Proof of International Student Insurance Policy by the first week of March. Failure to submit the Proof of International Student Insurance Policy will disqualify scholarship candidates from receiving scholarships the following semester.

## 1. Scholarship for International Students

### 1) Scholarship for International Students

● For the first semester, a partial tuition waiver is possible based on the applicant's level of TOPIK.

- ① Students with TOPIK Level 5 or higher : 100% Total tuition (Instruction Fee + admission fee) waived
- ② Students with TOPIK Level 4 : 60% of Instruction Fee waived
- ③ Students with TOPIK Level 2~3 : 50% of Instruction Fee waived
- ④ Students who have completed the Korean Language Course (Grade 3 or higher) at WKU : 50% of Instruction Fee waived
- ⑤ Students with Grade 2 or higher on WKU's TOPIK test : 50% of Instruction Fee waived
- ⑥ Students in arts or sports majors : 50% of Instruction Fee waived

2) From the second semester, a merit scholarship is applied depending upon a student's grade point average, from 30% to 60%, based on the Wonkwang University International Student Scholarship Regulations.

※ Students who do not have medical insurance will not be able to get a scholarship regardless of the their GPA.
